

# Interns Eligibility

## 1. Check the intern eligibility

To be admissible, the interns must respond to all the criteria listed below:

- Enrolled in a professional, college or university program at an accredited Canadian educational institution (CEGEP, Vocational Training Centre, college, or university) that includes a mandatory or optional WIL experience.
- Canadian citizen, permanent resident or have refugee status under the law.
- Legally entitled to work in Canada<sup>1</sup> under the laws and regulations of the province or territory in which they reside.

## 2. Determination of the funding rates

For every eligible intern you can determine which rate will apply:

- For regular interns: 50% of the gross salary, up to \$5000.
- For first-year trainees\* or trainees from diverse backgrounds\*\* in the labour market: 70% of the gross salary, up to \$7,000.
